Manchester Town Hall refurbishment

**Guest Speaker: John Lorimer
Head of Capital Programmes at MCC**

The refurbishment of the Town Hall in Manchester is one of the most challenging projects that the City has undertaken for many years and will be the catalyst for a significant transformation of the way the council works both internally and also in its interaction with the city. Procurement is under way at the present time and therefore it is of great significance to the construction community in the North West.

John Lorimer, Head of Capital Programmes at MCC, will take us through what the project entails and how it will affect not only the city centre but the whole culture of the council.
